LEGAL FRAMEWORK:

- Institutional Structure Reform at NBS (2025): Government Decision No. [464/2025](#) amending Government Decision No. [935/2018](#) **on the organisation and functioning of the National Bureau of Statistics**, approved on 16 July 2025.

Main activities under the structural reform:

- Establishment of a **Statistical Training Centre*** aimed at enhancing the professional capacities of staff within the NSS, as well as users and respondents.
- Consolidation of the National Accounts Division and the Agriculture Statistics Division to ensure the development of new statistical outputs in line with EU requirements.
- Reallocation of staff between regional and central offices to better align with current statistical production needs, while maintaining the total number of positions
- According to the GD No. [51/2022](#) **for the approval of the Regulation on the procedure for designating producers of official statistics (OPOS)**, the NBS collaborates with the public institutions to meet the criteria for OPOS designation.
 - Since September 2025: a series of training workshops were launched for OPOSs and other institutions, covering: statistical legislation, quality management system, confidentiality and data protection, dissemination of official statistics.

LEGAL FRAMEWORK:

- The **Statistical Work Programme (SWP) for 2025** (approved by GD. No. [897/2024](#)) specifies **10 innovative statistical works** to be carried out by the NBS supplemented with an additional chapter on **Experimental Statistics**.
 - The draft SWP for 2026, currently under review, includes **13 experimental statistical works** to be carried out by NBS.
- To further align sectoral data with the EU *acquis*, as well as to strengthen institutional capacities and modernise technical and statistical infrastructure supporting the production of statistics and alignment with EU requirements, **169 actions were included under Chapter 18 ‘Statistics’ of the National Programme for the Accession of the Republic of Moldova to the EU 2025-2029 (NPA)**, approved by Government Decision No. [306/2025](#):
 - **Annex A** – 83 actions for transposing EU legislation and
 - **Annex B** - 86 implementation actions.
- Within the **Reform Agenda under the Republic of Moldova’s Growth Plan for the years 2025-2027** approved by GD No. [260/2025](#), steps 22–24 are included under Reform 10, Sub-area ‘Statistics’, within Pillar 7 - Fundamentals.
 - **Scope:** to increase the production and dissemination of official statistics aligned with EU requirements, specifically in relation to: i) alignment of key macroeconomic indicators with ESA 2010, Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices (HICP) compilation, and the European Comparison Programme; ii) dissemination of final data from the 2024 Population and Housing Census (PHC) by grids; and iii) organisation of the 2030 round of the General Agricultural Census.

LEGAL FRAMEWORK:

- The NBS has prepared a draft **roadmap** for **the implementation of ESA 2010**, which is currently under consultation with Eurostat, and has also been discussed with the Ministry of Finance and the National Bank of Moldova.
- The draft **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)** between the NBS, the National Bank of Moldova (NBM), and the Ministry of Finance (MF) on data production for Government Finance Statistics (GFS) and the Excessive Deficit Procedure (EDP) is currently under consultation with the respective institutions.

➤ **THE AVAILABILITY OF SDG INDICATORS:**

Online **platform for SDG indicators** <https://statistica.gov.md/en/sustainable-development-goals-183.htwmilth> is constantly updated with data and metadata.

- **SDG 1.2.2** Multidimensional poverty index as part of the official statistics released;
- 2024 Population Census was conducted and new Statistical Surveys are to be carried out during 2025-2027 (such as such “Chid labour” (2025), Time Use Survey (2026), health survey (EHIS - 2026) or planned surveys on gender-based violence (2026), living conditions (EU-SILC - 2028), ICT on Household survey (2027)), or estimations of Prevalence of moderate or severe food insecurity on the basis of Household Budget Survey are to be done, to facilitate the production of data for the related **SDGs indicators 2.1.2, 4.4.1, 5.2.1, 5.2.2, 8.7.1, 11.7.2, 16.1.3, 16.2.3, 10.7.4** etc.
- **SDG 5.6.1** Proportion of women aged 15-49 years who make their own informed decisions regarding sexual relations, contraceptive use and reproductive health care (Generations and Gender Survey (GGS) being conducted twice)

II. Main achievements: Strengthening operational framework

QUALITY MANAGEMENT:

- In 2025, a user satisfaction survey "*User satisfaction level with NBS products and services*" was conducted:
 - **90% of respondents** have high or moderate trust in statistical data
 - **73%** are satisfied or very satisfied with the NBS website
 - **Top used domains:** Social statistics – population, labor force, living standards
 - **Usage:** 84% use the NBS website; 43% use the Statistical Database
- Single Integrated Metadata Structure (**SIMS**) - metadata were developed according to SIMS for 8 surveys/statistical activities for economic and social areas

IT INFRASTRUCTURE MODERNIZATION:

To integrate modern technologies and tools to enhance the production, analysis, and dissemination of data in support of a modern statistical system the IT infrastructure was modernised.

Priority actions undertaken:

- 28% of outdated **personal computers** were renewed (with the relevant software licenses) - to improve efficiency and reliability of daily operations
- Acquisition of updated **network hardware** to enable faster, more secure data exchange
- Procurement of **licensed software tools** critical for data analysis and secure **data storage**
- Implementation of **cybersecurity measures** to safeguard statistical databases and systems against external threats

II. Main achievements: Strengthening operational framework

EXTEND THE ACCESS AND USE OF ADS AND PRIVATELY HELD DATA:

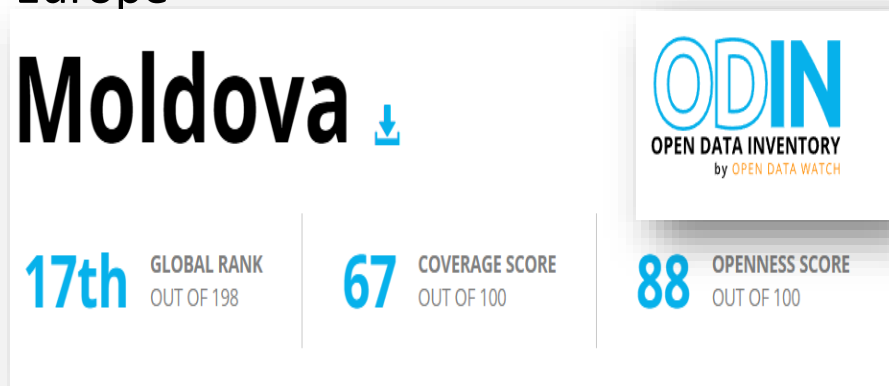
- In **January 2025**, NBS reconfirmed (biannually) the level of compliance of the management system in the field of "Production of official statistics" with ISO/IEC standards:
 - **ISO/IEC 27001:2022** on information security and
 - **ISO/IEC 27701:2019** on the protection of personal/confidential data
- NBS strengthened the **use of administrative and privately held data** to modernize production and align with EU practices.
 - ✓ NBS uses **over 45 alternative data sources** (administrative and private) for statistical purposes, of which **29 provide access to individual data**
- **Institutional Cooperation**
 - Draft **Statistical Work Programme (SWP) 2026** foresees **130 datasets** from **41 institutions** (statistical and administrative sources) to support official statistics

II. Main achievements: Modernized technical & technological infrastructure

MODERNISATION OF INFORMATION SYSTEMS (1)

ODIN – Open Data Watch assessment

- Open Data Inventory (ODIN) <http://odin.opendatawatch.com/> assesses the **coverage and** international standards of **openness** of official statistics websites
- The assessment includes 22 statistical categories from social, economic and environment domains
- In **2024 Republic of Moldova** ranked **No. 18** in the WORLD (out of 198 countries) and 3d in Eastern Europe

II. Main achievements: Modernized technical & technological infrastructure

MODERNISATION OF INFORMATION SYSTEMS (2)

- In **August 2025**, the NBS launched a new interactive dashboard on the Consumer Price Index (CPI) using Power BI - this tool improves accessibility and understanding of consumer price statistics and metadata

NEW STATISTICAL TOOLS: -

Statistical Classifications Aligned to EU Standards

- **Household expenditure classification** in accordance with **COICOP 2018** implemented within the Household Budget Survey starting with 2025.
- **Standard Classification of Education (ISCED)** - Interinstitutional Working group approved by the MER in 2025, between Ministry of Education and Research and the NBS (ongoing).
- **International Classification of Crime for Statistical Purposes (ICCS)** - Interinstitutional Working group between NBS, Ministry of Justice, General Prosecutor's Office, Ministry of Internal Affairs, Correspondence tables developed, validated, under testing by relevant institutions.
- A draft updated **Classification of Statistical Regions** (equivalent to NUTS) was prepared and sent to Eurostat for consultation.
- Work has started on developing the national version of **CAEM 2.1**, aligned with **NACE Rev. 2**.

II. Main achievements: Statistical processes & outputs – optimized and aligned

STATISTICAL METHODOLOGIES AND SURVEYS WERE IMPLEMENTED AND OPTIMIZED (1):

- **Starting from January 2025**, a new sampling framework (**EMDOS 3**) for household surveys was implemented, designed based on data from the **2024 Population and Housing Census**.
- The **Methodology and statistical tools** (data collection questionnaire and instructions) for **vacant job statistics**
- The **Labour Force Survey (LFS) Methodology** was revised to ensure better alignment with framework Regulation (EU) 2019/1700.
- **Energy statistics:**
 - (i) the **Methodology for calculating annual and monthly statistical indicators in the energy sector**,
 - (ii) the **Methodology for calculating statistical indicators on natural gas and electricity prices**
- **Starting from January 2025**, the updated statistical questionnaire "**Innovation in Industry and Services**" was implemented, developed in line with **Regulation (EU) 2022/1092** on technical specifications for data requirements on the topic of innovation.

II. Main achievements: Statistical processes & outputs – optimized and aligned

STATISTICAL METHODOLOGIES AND SURVEYS WERE IMPLEMENTED AND OPTIMIZED

(2):

- **January 2025**, the renewed questionnaire "**Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) in Enterprises**" was implemented, developed in accordance with *Regulation (EU) 2024/1883 on technical specifications for data requirements and deadlines for submission of metadata and quality reports for the topic "Use of ICT and e-Commerce"*.
- The production and quarterly dissemination of **statistics on job vacancies** was launched (previously, this survey was conducted annually).
- As of **January 2025**, several major changes were introduced in the **Household Budget Survey (HBS)**, which is conducted on a continuous basis:
 - data are collected using a new questionnaire developed in line with Regulations (EU) 2019/1700 and 2023/126;
 - the paper-assisted personal interview (PAPI) method was replaced with computer-assisted personal interviews (CAPI).
- A **working plan** was prepared for implementing the **EU survey on gender-based violence against women and other interpersonal violence**. Activities included development of methodology, questionnaire testing in 2025, and a workshop (22–23 July 2025) supported by Eurostat, UN Women, UNFPA.

II. Main achievements: statistical processes & outputs – optimized and aligned

EXPERIMENTAL DATA DEVELOPMENT in compliance with EU/UN requirements:

- In 2025, with the support of the **TAIEX** programme:
 - a pilot survey on **Global Value Chains (GVC)** in enterprises;
 - experimental calculations on **Foreign Affiliates Statistics (FATS)**;
 - a pilot survey on **Road Freight Transport (ASTRM)**.
- Experimental calculations of **At-risk-of-poverty rate** (relative poverty rate) and harmonised indices of consumer prices (HICPs)
- **Estate Agencies Rent Survey (EARS)** conducted (in July 2025) for the first time in the municipality of Chisinau, jointly with Eurostat and the International Service of Remunerations and Pensions (ISRP) of the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD).
 - This survey supports the implementation of Council Regulation No 31 (EEC), 11 (EAEC), Articles 64 regarding the adjustment of salaries and correction coefficients applicable to EU officials.

II. Main achievements: statistical processes & outputs – optimized and aligned

NEW HOUSEHOLD SURVEYS TO BE IMPLEMENTED (2025) in compliance with EU/UN requirements

Funds were allocated from the state budget to support three new surveys in households, complemented with assistance from development partners (UNICEF, ILO, UN Women, UNFPA, WHO):

- **EHIS** (European Health Interview Survey) survey: Collects health status, including self-perceived health, chronic conditions, and limitations in daily activities;
- **EU-GBV** (Gender-Based Violence Survey): Pilot survey, focusing on violence against women and other forms of interpersonal violence (to be continued in 2026);
- **Unpaid Care Work Module** within the Labour Force Survey: focuses on understanding and addressing the significant amount of unpaid work, particularly by women, in household and community settings

INTERNATIONAL TRAINING & CAPACITY BUILDING OF THE NBS STAFF

- New knowledge and experiences were gained by Moldovan statisticians through participation in expert working group meetings on specific statistical domains and regular trainings provided by the EC (Eurostat), as well as international partners, to align the national statistical system with European standards:
 - Training sessions organised by the **Eurostat**: 19 training sessions (2024–2025);
 - Training topics:**
 - ✓ ESS-MH, EDAMIS, SDMX
 - ✓ Linked Open Data, ESSPROS, National Accounts
 - ✓ EDP/GFS, Metadata-based production

- **Participation in expert working group meetings on specific statistical domains** organised by Eurostat and international partners:
 - 110 expert working group meetings (in 2024 -2025)
 - 82 participants from NBS and staff within other institutions involved in statistical production

Data-users oriented events aimed at enhancing statistical literacy & user capacity

- **Training sessions for users** were organised by NBS on a regular basis.
- **Purpose:** to **increase statistical literacy** and help different categories of users better understand and apply statistical data and to promote **the use of official statistics** in decision-making, research, education, and media.
- (2025) **7 training sessions** for users of official statistics were organised.
- **Topics covered:**
 1. *Gross Domestic Product (GDP) and Consumer Price Index (CPI) statistics* ([21 March 2025](#))
 2. *Introduction to official statistics* ([25 March 2025](#))

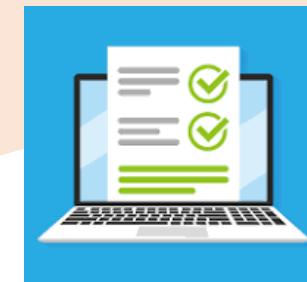

Survey (PES):

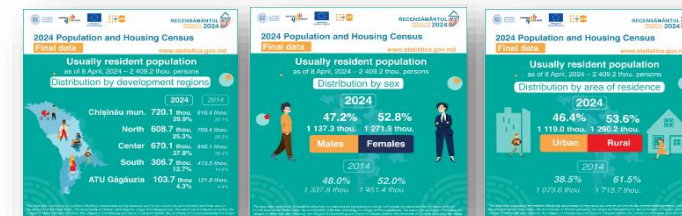
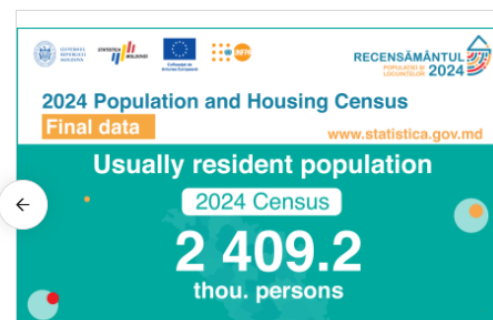

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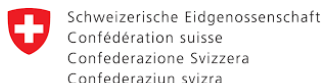
